Dear Parents and Carers,

We are excited to let you know that we will be holding a World War Two Day on Thursday 2nd April 2026.

To help bring the period to life, we would like all children to come to school dressed in a World War Two style outfit. This could be an evacuee costume, a 1940s outfit or anything inspired by the era. There is no expectation to buy anything: adapting the current school uniform or other clothes can work very well. We will be making gas mask boxes and evacuee labels so these are not needed as part of the outfit from home.



The children will take part in a 1940s-style lesson and experience a simulated air raid, helping them understand what life was like for children during the war. As part of our day, we will be walking to Burrow Hill to visit the WW2 monument.

In the afternoon, we are delighted to invite you to join us in the Main Hall from 2pm for an afternoon of singing and dancing, inspired by the music of the 1940s. Closer to the time, we will be sending each child home with two tickets.
